soos Vryheidsdag en Werkersdag. Ons vier ons demokrasie op 27 April, die datum waarop Suid-Afrika se eerste volle demokratiese verkiesing in 1994 plaasgevind het. Ek wil u aanmoedig om hierdie dag ook te vier met vreugde en dankbaarheid. Dit was 'n keerpunt in ons geskiedenis.

## Verkeersdruk

Ek verwelkom die gereelde kommentaar en terugvoer van ons inwoners oor Munisipale sake en toekomsplanne. Dit is noodsaaklik vir gesonde en deursigtige regering. So het die ondersoek na 'n moontlike westelike verbypad as 'n moontlike verligting van ons verkeersdruk, ook reeds baie terugvoer ontlok - baie daarvoor, sommiges daarteen. Dit is egter in hierdie stadium slegs 'n opsie wat ondersoek word. Die provinsiale regering het ingestem om te betaal vir 'n lewensvatbaarheidstudie hieroor. Ek sal u op hoogte hou oor die vordering. Ons moet egter alle moontlikhede ondersoek, want daar moet oplossings gevind word vir die ernstige verkeersdruk wat ons tans in Stellenbosch ervaar. Ons kyk egter ook na verskeie ander opsies soos parkeer-en-ry (park and ride), waar voertuie op die buitewyke van die dorp parkeer en dan met openbare vervoer inry, moontlike eenrigtingstrate, die ontwikkeling van parkeerplek vir busse en vele ander opsies. U kan gerus vir my skryf hieroor. En uiteraard sal daar openbare deelname prosesse wees hieroor.

## Munisipaliteit en Besigheid

U sal onthou dat ek 'n paar maande terug vir u genoem het dat ek begin het met die Burgemeester Besigheid-Forum. Sedert ons aanvangsvergadering het ons hard gewerk om die verteenwoordigers van die onderskeie sektore te kontak en opvolgvergaderings te hou. Ek het saam met die Burgemeesterskomitee en direkteure dan ook onlangs afgevaardigdes ontmoet van die eiendomsontwikkelingssektor waar ons uitdagings en ons drome vir ons area vir die toekoms bespreek het. Daarna het ons ook nog 'n vergadering gehou met verteenwoordigers van verskeie besigheidsektore. Dit is opwindend om te sien hoeveel mense ons visie vir 'n sterk en volhoubare ekonomie vir die groter Stellenbosch deel. En dit is net so goed om van huidige struikelblokke te verneem.

## CAN-projek

Graag herinner ek u dat die Eikestad-inkopiesentrum die versamelpunt is vir die Stellenbosch CAN-projek. Hierdie projek samel blikkieskos in vir Stellenbosch Voedingsaksie. Die blikkieskos word gebruik om maaltye voor te berei vir mense in nood. Ek ondersteun heelhartig hierdie projek en wil dankie sê vir al die rolspelers en almal wat al geskenk het. ## Begroting

Ek het aan die einde van Maart ons konsepbegroting ter tafel gelê. Dit is 'n konserwatiewe begroting met die klem op infrastruktuur vir basiese dienslewering. Ons sou graag nuwe en lekker projekte wou aanpak, maar daar is soveel opgraderings en ou projekte wat voltooi moet word, dat ons eers gaan fokus

and Workers Day. We celebrate our democracy on 27 April, the date on which South Africa's first fully democratic election took place in 1994. I want to encourage you to celebrate this day with joy and gratefulness. It was a turning point in our history.

## Traffic congestion

I welcome the regular comments and feedback from our residents regarding municipal issues and plans for the future. It is necessary for healthy and transparent governance. The possibility of a western bypass, to relieve traffic congestion, received a lot of reaction, mostly for the proposal and some opposing it. At this stage, it is however just a suggestion that is being investigated. The provincial government has agreed to fund a feasibility study. I will keep you informed of the progress. We must however investigate all possibilities because solutions have to be found for the extreme congestion that we are currently experiencing in Stellenbosch. We are also looking at several other options, for example park and ride, where vehicles are parked on the outskirts of town and then drive in with public transportation, possible one-way streets, the development of parking space for buses and many other options. You can write to me in this regard. And of course, public participation processes will form part of this.

## Municipality and Business

You will remember that a few months ago I have mentioned to you that I launched the Mayoral Business Forum. Since our first meeting we have worked hard to contact the representatives of the different sectors and to conduct follow-up meetings. Along with the Mayoral Committee and the directors, I recently met with some representatives of the property development sector, where we discussed our dreams for the future for our area. This was followed by a meeting with representatives of several business sectors. It is exciting to see how many people share our vision for a strong and sustainable economy for the greater Stellenbosch. And it is just as important to hear about some of our current obstacles.

## CAN project

I would like to remind you that the Eikestad Mall is the collection point for the Stellenbosch CAN project. This project collects canned foods for Stellenbosch Feeding in Action. The canned food is used to prepare meals for people in need. I whole-heartedly support this project and want to thank all the role-players and everyone that have made donations. The goal is to collect 20 000 cans this year. The project runs until the end of May and I want to encourage everyone to make a donation to this project. ## Budget

At the end of March, I tabled the concept budget. It is a conservative budget with the focus on infrastructure for basic service delivery. We would have liked to take on new and fun projects, but there are so many upgrades and old projects that need to be completed that we are first going to focus on

## Building plans

We recently learnt that several institutions and people developed or built without building plans or approval. It means that those properties are not registered or being properly taxed. If you are possibly in such a position, please rectify it quickly and voluntarily because if it is discovered large fines will be issued. Furthermore, it is unfair that everyone does not contribute to the municipal income. The bigger and more extensive the tax sources are, the lower the rates will be. In due time we will also be addressing illegal electricity systems and illegal home shops. Let us all work together to ensure a just system for everyone.
