## UCI Bergfiets Wêreldbeker

Ek is kinderlik opgewonde omdat ons daarin kon slaag om die eerste been van die UCI Wêreldbeker, wat in Maart 2018 gehou gaan word, vir Stellenbosch te verkry. Dit is die enigste plek in Afrika waar 'n been van hierdie kompetisie plaasvind! En daarmee saam gaan die EPIC net die week vantevore ook in Stellenbosch begin! Ek het dan ook onlangs met die organiseerders en Minister Alan Winde vergader om te gesels oor hierdie wêreldklasgeleentheid en wat dit alles vir die groter Stellenbosch kan beteken. Werkskepping, 'n enorme ekonomiese inspuiting en spesifieke vaardigheidsopleiding is 'n belangrike deel van die pad vorentoe en provinsie gaan fondse bewillig om plaaslike inwoners op te lei as tegnisi om aan fietse te werk. Ek gaan ook 'n hand bysit om die organiseerders en besighede met mekaar in kontak te bring sodat die volle potensiaal van die geleentheid ontgin kan word. Stellenbosch se gewildheid onder veral bergfietsryers neem vinnig toe en ons is reeds 'n basis vir internasionale fietsryers waar hulle kom oefen en kom bly selfs vir maande aaneen. Soos die beplanning ontvou sal ek u op hoogte hou van waar en hoe u moontlik betrokke kan raak. Hou ook die pers dop vir meer inligting.

## Nuwe Fietsryroete

Dit is 'n opwindende nuwe inisiatief en nog roetes gaan later in die provinsie bekend gestel word.

## UCI Mountain Bike World Cup

I am very excited that we succeeded in our efforts to secure the hosting of the first leg of the UCI Mountain Bike World Cup, to be held in March 2018, here in Stellenbosch. It is the only place in Africa where this competition will be taking place! And to top it all, the EPIC will start in Stellenbosch just one week earlier! I recently met with the organisers and Minister Alan Winde to talk about this world class event and what it will mean for the greater Stellenbosch area. Job creation, a significant economic injection and skills training are extremely important going forward and the Provincial Government has made funds available that will train local residents as technicians to repair bicycles. I will also lend a hand to bring together the organisers and local businesses to make sure we capitalise on this opportunity. Stellenbosch is growing in popularity especially amongst mountain bikers and has already become a base for international cyclists where they train and reside for months on end. As the planning moves forward I will keep you informed about how and where you could possibly get involved. Keep an eye on the local news media for information.

## New Cycling Route

Cycling is very fashionable at the moment and I hope it inspires you to get out your bicycle and start peddling. It was a great privilege for me to launce the CrossCape Cycle Route with Minister Winde on 11 May 2017. The first route in the Western Cape starts in Stellenbosch! The idea is that tourists (both local and international) cycle from town to town, exploring these routes and that services and amenities catering for their specific needs be available along the route. It is an exciting new initiative and more routes will be launched in the province at a later date.

## Clean Audit

More good news is that we recently received our trophy from the Auditor General for our Municipality's clean audit outcome for the financial year of 2015/16 which was announced in December. The clean audit is proof that the Municipality's financial management is in order and adheres to all the prescribed legislation. I am determined and committed to uphold these high standards of financial management and will not tolerate

## Dienslewering

My eerste begroting fokus absoluut op dienslewering vir alle gemeenskappe, want my droom vir die groter Stellenbosch is 'n plek wat geleenthede aan almal moet bied. Daarom is die klem ook op broodnodige infrastruktuur. Dit vorm die fondasie van alles wat ons graag wil bereik en as ons nie behoorlik hieraan werk nie, sal geen van ons aspirasies verwesenlik word nie. Hiermee skep ons ook die fondasie vir toekomstige welvaartontwikkeling. Dit is dus 'n begroting sonder frille en valletjies, inderdaad 'n platform vir dienslewering.

## Spaar Water

U is seker al moeg daarvan om te hoor van watertekorte, maar ek kan die belangrikheid hiervan nie genoeg beklemtoon nie. Water is lewe, sonder water sal alles gaan stilstaan. Daarom wil ek u weer herinner dat ons uiters ernstige waterbeperkings het en dit sal so bly vir die voorsienbare toekoms. Ek bid dat ons gedurende die winter goeie reën sal ontvang, maar selfs 'n uitsonderlike reënseisoen is op dié stadium nie genoeg om die damme so vol te maak dat ons beperkings sal kan lig nie. Our primary goal is to deliver services and to create a municipal environment which creates opportunities for all residents. Once again, I want to thank the Chief Financial Officer and all the officials who worked so hard to ensure that we do everything in accordance with the law.

## Budget

At the end of May, the final budget for the new financial year will serve before Council. This will happen following the conclusion of the public participation process and the Integrated Development Plan (IDP)-meetings that took place during April. I want to thank everyone who participated in the meetings and gave their input. Your inputs are extremely important because it gives us an indication of what you expect of the Municipality and what you would like us to pay more attention to. We study every input we receive and it is considered before the final budget is assembled.

## Service Delivery

My first budget solely focuses on service delivery to all communities because my dream for the greater Stellenbosch is to be a place that provides opportunities to all. That is why the focus for this budget is on essential infrastructure. Infrastructure forms the foundation of what we want to achieve and if it does not function properly, we will not be able to realise any of our aspirations. This is also the foundation from which we develop future wealth. It is therefore a no fuss budget, truly a platform for service delivery.

## Save Water

You are probably tired of hearing about the water shortages but I can not impress on you enough the seriousness of the situation. Water is life and without it everything will come to a stand still. That is why I want to remind you again that we still have serious water restrictions and it will remain in place for the foreseeable future. I pray that we receive good rains during the winter, but even an exceptional rainy season might not be enough to fill the dams to such a level where we can lift the restrictions. I want to encourage every resident to make the extra effort and save every little bit of water. Every drop is precious!

Recently, I was told of a situation where I was unsure of whether I should laugh or cry! Somebody stole a tap from the house of our Speaker. The person was however conscientious enough to close the stopcock before doing so!

## Your Inputs are Important

With every new Council Term it is wise to review all the by-laws to ensure that they adhere to the changing requirements and circumstances in our towns as well as amendments to the existing legislation. As the review process progresses, you will see requests for your input and participation published in the local media. Your inputs are important because these by-laws are enforced and upheld in your area. If you do not bring the problem to our attention, we cannot address it properly.
