Hannah Cornelius is ontvoer en vermoor, haar vriend aangerand en vir dood agtergelaat en 'n 7-jarige meisie van Cloeteville is na bewering verkrag. Ons innige simpatie en gebede gaan uit na hierdie slagoffers se familie en vriende.

Hierdie gebeure het my tot stilstand geruk en het my baie nagte laat wakker lê en wroeg oor wat ek binne my beperkte mandaat kan doen vir die veiligheid van al ons inwoners.

Misdaadvoorkoming Crime prevention

Soos ek reeds in 'n vorige skrywe genoem het, laat die wet ons nie toe om ons eie metro polisiemag te hê nie. Ons is egter in die proses om die wetstoepassingseenheid te hersien en te vergroot. Hulle kan die SAPD help met sigbare polisiëring indien hulle so versoek word. Ek wil inwoners aanmoedig om betrokke te raak by u plaaslike buurtwag. Indien u area nie oor een beskik nie, kan u een begin. As u onseker is oor hoe om te werk te gaan kan u die Burgemeesterskomiteelid vir Veiligheid en Sekuriteit, Quintin Smit (Quintin.Smit@stellenbosch.gov.za), kontak vir meer inligting. As inwoners, kan ons so 'n bydrae maak om die sigbare polisiëeringsnetwerk te versterk en so misdaad help voorkom. Ek wil u verseker dat ons alles in ons vermoë doen om die polisie en ander rolspelers by te staan om misdaad te bekamp.

Dear Residents,



Unfortunately, I have to start this month on a sad note. Recently the greater Stellenbosch Community was traumatised by shocking incidences of crime. Hannah Cornelius was kidnapped and killed, her friend viciously attacked and left for dead and a 7 year old girl from Cloeteville has allegedly been raped. Our heartfelt condolences and prayers go out to the victims' family and friends.

These events shocked me deeply and have kept me up many nights since then thinking about what I, with my limited mandate, could do for the safety of our residents.

As I mentioned in a previous communication, the law does not allow us to have a metro police force. We are however in the process of reviewing and expanding our law enforcement unit. They can assist the SAPS with visible policing in case they are requested to do so. I want to encourage residents to become involved with a local neighbourhood watch. If your area does not have one, you can start one. If you are unsure on how to go about establishing a neighbourhood watch, please contact our Mayoral Committee member for Safety and Security, Quintin Smit (Quintin.Smit@stellenbosch.gov.za). As residents, we can contribute by strengthening visible policing and so help to prevent crime. I want to assure you that we are doing everything in our power to assist the police and other role players to prevent crime.

'n Nuwe toepassing



Ons is tans besig met 'n baie opwindende toetslopie vir 'n nuwe toepassing (app) wat op slimfone gelaai kan word om mense in 'n noodsituasie te help. Die Munisipaliteit het so pas 'n ses maande ooreenkoms geteken met skeppers van die Namola-toepassing. Hierdie toepassing dien as 'n mobiele paniekknoppie. Wanneer dit gedruk word ontbied dit die naaste wetstoepassingshulp deur middel van u GPS-koördinate. Die toetslopie word tans gratis aan die Munisipaliteit gebied waarna ons die sukses daarvan sal oorweeg en 'n moontlike ooreenkoms met die skeppers sal sluit. Verskeie rolspelers, insluitend munisipale wetstoepassing neem deel hieraan. Al wat u moet doen is om die toepassing op u foon af te laai en dit te aktiveer. In die geval van nood, gebruik u dan die Namola-toepassing om die naaste hulp te ontbied. Die Namola-toepassing is beskikbaar op die iTunes- en Google play-winkels en kan op enige iPhone- of Android-toestel gelaai word. Laat weet ons gerus wat u ervaring met die toepassing is. Uiteraard verwag ons aanvanklik geboortepyne met so 'n nuwe stelsel en u terugvoering sal ons help om hierdie probleme uit te stryk. Skryf gerus vir my! Dit is 'n innoverende stap in die stryd teen misdaad en u terugvoering is vir ons belangrik.

Spaar asb water!

Ons is dankbaar vir die lekker reën van die afgelope tyd. Dit is egter net 'n klein bydrae en nog glad nie genoeg om die ernstige droogte te breek nie. Die Raad het dan ook ons gebied nou tot rampgebied verklaar. Ons vind egter steeds dat daar mense is wat nou dink dat die droogte verby is. Hulle gebruik water net soos hulle wil en gee glad nie agting aan die waterbeperkings nie. Die huidige vlak 4 waterbeperkings sal geld tot en met verdere kennisgewing. Ek wil u dus daaraan herinner dat u water uiters spaarsamig moet gebruik. Elke inwoner moet sy gebruik probeer beperk tot 100 liter per dag. Die vlak 4 waterbeperkingsstariewe tree nou in en is nodig om waterverbruik te beperk en om onnodige vermorsing te beperk. Ek doen weer 'n ernstige beroep op elkeen van u, SPAAR ASB WATER! Praat ook met u bure, kinders, vriende en selfs werknemers daarvoor. Ons moet bewusheid skep oor die probleem en mekaar verantwoordbaar hou. Indien ons dieselfde reënval kry as verlede jaar, sal ons damme steeds leegloop in Mei 2018!

A new app



We are currently busy with a very exciting test run for a new application (app) that can be downloaded onto any smartphone to assist people in need. The Municipality just signed an agreement for 6 months with the creators of the Namola-app. This app functions as a mobile panic button. When it is pressed, it summons law enforcement assistance to your location by providing your GPS-coordinates. This test run is being provided to the Municipality for free. After the test period the success of test run will be considered and a longer term agreement may follow. Various stakeholders including the Municipal Law Enforcement are partaking in the trial. All you need to do is to download the app on your phone and to activate it. In case of emergency, you will use the Namola-app to summons help. The Namola-app is available in the iTunes and Google Play Stores and can be installed on any Android or iPhone device. Please let me know about your experiences with the app is. We do expect some teething problems during this test phase and your feedback will help in ironing out any issues. It is an innovate step in our efforts to prevent crime and your feedback is important.

Please save water!

We are grateful for the rain we recently received. It is however a very small contribution to what is needed and it is not nearly enough to break the severe drought. We do find that there are people who are under the impression the drought has now passed! They use water as they see fit and without any regard for the water restrictions in place. The current level 4 water restrictions will remain in place until further notice. I want to remind you to use water very sparingly. Every resident must try and limit their daily use to 100 litres. The level 4 water restriction tariffs has now kicked in and is aimed at saving water and restricting water wastage. I again urge every resident to PLEASE SAVE WATER! Talk about this with your neighbours, children, friends and even your employer. We need to create awareness about this and hold one another accountable. If we receive the same amount of rain as in 2016, we will have no surface water left by May 2018!

A big thank you goes out to the residents of Ward 2 in Franschhoek, who quickly rendered assistance in Langrug during the crisis. I am so proud to see and experience how our communities unite in a time of need.

The cold weather highlighted the need in poor communities for articles like clothes and blankets. 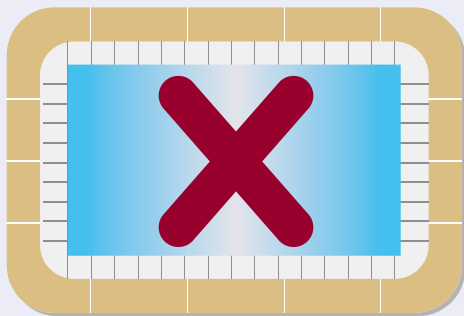
