ons sonder foute is nie en daar is steeds baie om te verbeter. En natuurlik waarborg 'n skoon oudit nie dienslewering nie, maar u kan verseker wees ons werk onverpoosd om aanhoudend ons dienslewering te verbeter.

## Ernstige Droogte

Soos u almal weet het die droogte in ons provinsie vererger en nou kritieke afmetings aangeneem. Ons het dan ook pas Vlak 6 waterbeperkings afgekondig. Die helfte van die somer is nog oor en daar is geen teken van goeie reën vir die volgende paar maande nie. Intendeel word uiterste hitte verwag. Ons het 'n goeie Droogte Weerstandspan in werking en het reeds al ons bestaande boorgate getoets, nuwes geboor en toerusting daarvoor aangeskaf. 'n Addisionele begroting van R36 miljoen is begroot en gebruik hiervoor. Die addisionele water sal egter net aan ons basiese behoeftes voorsien en ons voorsien dat die damme sal leegloop in Mei vanjaar. Dan sal ons boorgate al bron van water wees, en ons bereken tans dat ons net 52% van die normale toevoer sal kan verskaf. U moet asseblief alles doen wat u kan om elke liter water te bespaar. Elke liter is kosbaar.

## Boorgate

Baie mense vra waarom boor ons nie meer gate nie en baie mense boor dan ook hul eie boorgate en sommige mense verkoop selfs water! Daar is egter nie onbepaalde hoeveelhede grondwater nie en die Nasionale Regering het pas aangekondig dat hul nou boorgatgebruik gaan begin reguleer met waterinspekteurs. Dit is onwettig om boorgatwater te verkoop of te koop tensy 'n verkoper ingevolge die Waterwet geregistreer is as 'n gemagtigde verkoper.

Uiteraard het spesiale aksies ook 'n impak op die begroting en waterpryse. Ons probeer dus die middeweg volg, want in die huidige ekonomie kan baie mense nie nog verhoogde belastings bekostig nie. En sou dit reën, sal hierdie maatreëls natuurlik nie meer nodig wees nie. Natuurlik is daar sekere mense wat blaam wil uitdeel en sê dat ons moes voorsien die droogte gaan kom. Dis egter 'n baie komplekse probleem, want die ongehoorde droë winter was 'n eerste ooit. Wie van ons het in April geglo dat daar feitlik geen reën sal wees nie? Wat dit egter nog moeiliker maak is die feit dat die mandaat oor water en damme en die finansiering daarvan by Nasionale Regering berus. Plaaslike owerhede se mandaat is hoofsaaklik die verspreiding en regulering van water. Ons is egter beter voorberei en gereed as die meeste ander munisipaliteite in die droogtegebied en met verantwoordelike gebruik, behoort ons ook hierdie krisis te kan oorleef.

## Spaar Water, Studente

Met die begin van die nuwe jaar verwelkom ons ook weer ons studente in ons dorp. Julle is baie welkom! Onthou, julle is nou volwaardige inwoners van Stellenbosch en ons dra julle belange ook op die hart. Ek doen 'n beroep op veral die nuwe studente om hulself te vergewis van ons waterbeperkings en dit asseblief toe te pas by u koshuis, woonstel en klaskamers. Ons het julle samewerking ten alle tye nodig om ons waterverbruik te beperk.

improvement. And of course, a clean audit does not automatically mean service delivery, but we work relentlessly to make sure our service delivery improves.

## Serious Drought

As you all know, the drought situation in the province has worsened and has now reached crisis levels. We have also announced Level 6 water restrictions. With half of the summer months still ahead, there are no signs of rain in the coming months; on the contrary we are expecting extreme heat. We have deployed a very good drought response plan and have already tested all our existing boreholes, drilled new ones and obtained the necessary equipment. An additional budget of R36 million has been budgeted and used for this. The additional water will only be able to provide for our most basic needs. Our forecasts indicate that the dams will run dry by May of this year. Our boreholes will then be our only source of water. We estimate that we will only be able to supply 52% of our normal supply. You must please do everything you can to save every litre of water. Every litre is valuable.

## Boreholes

Many people ask why we don't just drill additional holes. Many people do just drill their own boreholes. Some even sell the water they get from the boreholes. There is however not an unlimited supply of groundwater and the National Government has just announced that they will start regulating borehole usage by means of water inspectors. It is illegal to sell or to buy borehole water unless the seller is registered, in terms of the Water Act, as a legally approved seller.

Of course these special actions also have an impact on the budget and on the water prices. We therefore try to follow the middle ground, because in the current economy people cannot afford increased tariffs. And if it rains, all of these measures will no longer be necessary. There are of course some people who want to assign blame and say that we should have made earlier drought provisions. It is however, a much more complex problem due to the extreme dry winter, a first for the region. Who would have believed in April last year that we will receive almost no rain? What makes the situation more complicated is that the mandate over water and dams, as well as the financing thereof, resides with the National Government. Local Government's mandate is mainly responsible for the distribution and regulation of water. We are however more prepared and ready than many other municipalities in the drought affected region and with responsible use, we should be able to survive the crisis.

## Save Water, Students

With the start of the New Year we also welcome back our students to our towns. You are very welcome! Remember, you are full-fledged residents of Stellenbosch and we take your interests to heart. I call on, especially the new students, to please make yourselves aware of our water restrictions and to please apply it in your residence, flat or classroom. We need your full cooperation at all times to limit our water usage.



## Waterboetes

Ons inwoners werk meestal baie mooi saam met ons en oor die algemeen word daar gehoor gegee aan ons beperkings. Daar is egter steeds sondebokke wat selfsugtig is en voortgaan asof alles normaal is. Ons sal dit nou met alle erns en vinnig aanspreek deur die uitreiking van boetes. Die Landdros het ons kitsboetes in beginsel aanvaar. Oortreders kan verwag dat substansiële boetes uitgereik gaan word en hul water kan ook beperk word indien hul nie wil saamwerk nie. ## Vlak 6 Beperkings

Soos reeds vermeld, het ons dan ook ons waterbeperkings verhoog na Vlak 6 ooreenkomstig die Regulasie van Nasionale Regering wat op 12 Desember 2017 uitgereik is.

Wat behels dit? Die kennisgewing vereis dat alle industriële en huishoudelike waterverbruik met 45% en alle landbouwaterverbruik met 60% ingekort word. Dit word gebaseer op die gemiddelde waterverbruik vanaf 2010/11 tot 2014/15. Stellenbosch self moet dus in totaal sowat 46% minder water gebruik en is tans by sowat 44%.

Alle persone moet hul daaglikse waterverbruik beperk tot die voorgeskrewe 87 liter per dag. Dit beteken dat enige persoon se gekombineerde gebruik by die werk, huis en enige ander plek waar hy/sy mag verkeer, nie meer as 87 liter per dag mag wees nie. Die totaal vir alle huishoudings word beperk tot 10.5 kiloliter per maand. Dit word bereken op 4 persone per huishouding wat slegs 87 liter per persoon per dag gebruik. Huishoudings wat groter is as 4 persone kan aansoek doen vir 'n hoër gebruik gebaseer op die addisionele persone. Dis regtig nie baie water nie en u sal mooi moet werk om hoë verbruikboetes te voorkom.

## Waterwenke

*Maklike spaarwenke sluit in:*

- Stort (nie langer as 2 minute nie) eerder as bad en stort net wanneer dit nodig is.
- Sit 'n emmer in die stort en vang die water op. Gebruik dit om die toilet mee te spoel.
- Spoel die toilet slegs wanneer dit absoluut nodig is
- Gebruik waterlose handskoonmakers om jou hande mee te skoon te maak eerder as om jou hande te was.
- Was slegs 'n vol bondel wasgoed, eerder as om een of twee items op 'n slag te was en moenie klere was as dit nie regtig nodig is nie.

## Brandseisoen

Ons is nou ook in die hart van brandseisoen en daar was reeds verskeie voorvalle gedurende Desember. Ek wil inwoners asseblief vra om uiters versigtig met oop vlamme te wees. Omdat dit so droog is, versprei brande baie vinnig en kan 'n klein ongeluk tot 'n katastrofe lei. Let daarop dat geen vure gemaak mag word in munisipale parke en groenspasies nie. Wanneer u 'n vuur aansteek vir braai, moet dit nooit onbewaak gelos word

## Water Fines

Overall our residents are cooperating very well and adhere to the restrictions. However, there are a few bad apples who selfishly go ahead as per normal. We will now address it quickly and seriously by issuing fines. The magistrate has in principle approved our fast fines. Transgressors can now expect to be issued with a substantial fine and their water will also be restricted if they do not cooperate. ## Level 6 Restrictions

As already mentioned, we have raised the water restrictions to Level 6 in accordance with the Regulation of the National Government issued on 12 December 2017.

What does this entail? The notice requires that all industries and household water consumption be reduced to 45 % and all agricultural consumption to 60%. This is based on our average water consumption from 2010/11 to 2014/15. Stellenbosch therefore must reduce its consumption to 46% and we are currently at 44%.

All persons must limit their daily water usage to 87 litres per day. This means that any person's combined water consumption at work, home and any other place he or she may go throughout the day, must not exceed 87 litres per day. The total of all households are limited to 10.5 kilolitres per month. This is calculated on 4 persons per household using only 87 litres per person per day. Households larger than 4 people can apply for a higher usage based on the additional persons in the house. It is really not a lot of water and you will have to work sparingly to avoid fines.

## Waterwenke

*Easy tips for saving water include:*

- Shower (no longer than 2 minutes) instead of taking a bath and shower only when necessary.
- Place a bucket in the shower and collect the runoff water. Use this to flush the toilets with.
- Flush toilets only when absolutely necessary.
- Use waterless hand sanitizers to clean your hands instead of washing it.
- Only wash full loads of laundry instead of one or two items at a time and only wash when it is really necessary.

## Fire Season

We are also in the middle of fire season and there already were several incidents during December. I want urge residents to be extremely careful with open flames. Because it is so dry, fires spread very quickly and a small accident can result in a catastrophe. Take note that no fires are allowed in municipal parks or green spaces. When you light a fire for a braai, do not leave it unattended and keep a bucket with sand or water at hand
