

Level 5 Water Restrictions

Restrictions applicable to all customers



Boreholes and wellpoints must be registered with the municipality

Boreholes and wellpoints must be used efficiently to avoid wastage and evaporation.

No topping up of swimming pools with municipal drinking water allowed, even if fitted with a pool cover. No Watering/ irrigation with municipal drinking water

Properties where alternative non-drinking water are used, must display signage visible to the public

NO washing/ hosing down of hard-surfaced or paved areas with municipal drinking water allowed

Use of municipal drinking water for ornamental water fountains or water features are prohibited

Restrictions applicable to residential customers

Single residential properties must not exceed 20 000 litres per month / or 87 litres per person per day – whichever is the lowest

Cluster developments (flats and housing complexes) consuming more than 20 000 litres per unit per month will be liable to an admission of guilt fine

No washing of vehicles, trailers, caravans or boats with municipal drinking water allowed

No increase of indigent water

Guesthouses must reduce consumption to 30% below that of 2016 during the same period

Commercial properties must ensure monthly consumption of

consumption of municipal drinking water is reduced by 20% compared to consumption for the previous year

Agricultural users must ensure monthly consumption of municipal drinking water is reduced by 30% compared to

consumption for the

previous year

Install water efficient parts, fittings and technologies to minimize water usage

Operation of spray parks is prohibited

For users supplied with water in terms of special contracts, the contract conditions shall apply.

Failure to comply will constitute an offence in terms of the Municipality's Water Services By-Law (2017). This provision is effective from 22 September 2017.
