

STELLENBOSCH MUNICIPALITY CALLS FOR NOMINATIONS OF SUITABLY QUALIFIED AND EXPERIENCED PROFESSIONALS TO BE APPOINTED AS MEMBERS OF THE STELLENBOSCH MUNICIPAL PLANNING TRIBUNAL

In terms of Section 70(1) of the Stellenbosch Land Use Planning Bylaw (2015), the Stellenbosch Municipality must establish a Municipal Planning Tribunal (MPT) to decide on land use and land development applications. The term of office of the current MPT will end at the end of February 2023. Accordingly, an invitation is extended in terms of Section 72(1)(b) for nominations of persons who meet the requirements to be appointed on the MPT as external members for the next term of office, which will start on 1 March 2023.

The members of the MPT must have knowledge and experience of land use planning or the law related thereto and be representative of a broad range of experience and expertise. The responsibilities of MPT members will include the preparation for meetings by reading the planning reports, attendance and participation in monthly meetings of the MPT, attending site inspections as may be required, verifying minutes from meetings, and any other duties and functions provided for in the legislation.

Members will be appointed for a term of office and with such renumeration as determined by Council, and subject to terms and conditions.
