RE: WEMMERSHOEK WATER TREATMENT PLANT PRODUCTION FLOW REDUCTION

The City of Cape Town, Water and Sanitation Directorate, will reduce production/flow to **100MI/day** at the Wemmershoek Water Treatment Plant to accommodate maintenance work. This flow reduction is scheduled for Tuesday, 21 January 2025, from 08:00 until 16:00.

Parts of the Drakenstein and Stellenbosch Municipality, private consumers along the Wemmershoek pipeline, and the Bloekombos connection in Kraaifontein will be affected. We urge big consumers on the Wemmershoek pipeline to maintain minimum consumption during this period.

Please make the necessary arrangements to prepare for this flow reduction. Please ensure that your reservoirs are filled to maintain your consumers' supply.
