Cloetesville-area om persoonlik historiese titelaktes aan van die ouer begunstigdes, wat al omtrent 40 jaar wag, te oorhandig. Ons het sedert 2016 reeds meer as 2100 titelaktes oorgegee aan die geregtigheid begunstigdes. Baie van die aktes was histories van aard, met ander woorde projekte wat al dekades terug voltooi is. Ons het die afgelope paar jaar regtig hard gewerk om veral die historiese agterstand aan te spreek en uit te wis. Dit breek eenvoudig my hart wanneer ons met die historiese aktes werk en hoor van mense wat intussen afgestervet het sonder dat hulle ooit hulle huis self besit het. Ek kan nie help om saam met die oom of tannie te huil wanneer hulle met dankbaarheid die stukkie papier ontvang wat hul vir die eerste keer eienaars van eiendom maak nie. Dis van onskatbare waarde en bly vir my 'n prioriteit.

Tuinkompetisie

Ek speel al 'n rukkie rond met die idee vir 'n tuinkompetisie. Ek is self 'n kranige tuinier en wanneer ek in die tyd het woeker te lekker in die grond. Wanneer ek in ons gemeenskappe rond beweeg verwonder ek my aan die pragtige, innoverende en unieke tuine wat mense plant en onderhou. Selfs inwoners wat nie noodwendig baie spasie of groot erwe het nie, maak die mooiste en merkwaardigste tuine. 'n Tuin, klein of groot, maak 'n reuse verskil aan die inwoners wat naby dit bly en help met die mooimaak van ons dorpe. Dit skep trots en moedig ander inwoners aan om ook trots te hê in waar hulle bly. Daarom wil ons graag 'n tuinmaakkompetisie hou!

Ons werk nog aan die besonderhede en presies hoe ons dit gaan aanpak, maar begin solank beplan en woeker. Lente is om die draai en met die goeie reënval sover, weet ek dat die inwoners met groenvingers se hande reeds jeuk om weer in die grond te krap. Kyk uit op al ons nuusblaais vir inligting. Ek kan nie wag om al die mooi skeppings, klein en groot, te kom besoek nie.

Ereburgerskap – Jaap Durand

Ek het onlangs die ongelooflike voorreg gehad om ereburgerskap aan Professor Jaap Durand te oorhandig. Professor Durand is 'n legende in die akademiese en teologiese wêreld. Hy is 'n Alumnus van die Universiteit Stellenbosch en het bekendheid verwerf tydens sy jare by die Universiteit van Wes-Kaapland as Visie-Rektor. Professor Durand is 'n bekende anti-apartheidsaktivis wat hom daarop toegespits het om 'n meer inklusiewe akademiese omgewing te bou vir studente en akademici by UWK. Hy is ook mede-auteur van die Belhar Belydenis wat vandag deur gereformeerde kerke regoor die wêreld gebruik word.

Professor Durand is deur lede van die burgerlike organisasie #MyStellenbosch genomineer vir ereburgerskap en na al die voorskrifte van die munisipale beleid nagekom is, was dit my groot voorreg om die eerbewys aan hom te oorhandig. Ons wou graag 'n meer formele geleentheid aan die Durand gesin bied, maar as gevolg van COVID-19 en die gepaardgaande regulasies, en in oorleg met die Durand-gesin, het ons 'n intieme, COVID veilige geleentheid gehou met slegs Professor

waiting more than 40 years. Since 2016, we have handed over more than 2100 title deeds to the rightful beneficiaries. Many of these deeds are from historical projects, meaning projects that were completed a long time ago, sometimes decades. We have really worked hard these past few years to clear the backlog of deeds. It simply breaks my heart when we deal with historical deeds and learn of people who passed away before they ever had ownership of the homes. I cannot help but cry along with the beneficiaries when they gratefully receive that piece of paper that transforms them into the owners of their own property. It is of immeasurable value and remains a priority for me.

Gardening Competition

I have been playing around with the idea of having a gardening competition. I am also an enthusiastic gardener and when I have time I love digging around in the soil. When I go around in our communities, I am in awe of the beautiful, innovative and unique gardens that our residents have planted and are maintaining. Even residents who have limited space have created the most amazing and remarkable gardens. A garden, large or small, makes a huge difference to the residents who live nearby and helps with the beautification of our towns. It creates pride and encourages residents to also have pride in where they live. That is why we want to have a gardening competition.

We are still working on the details and how exactly we will go about it but now is as a good a time as any to start planning and working. Spring is around the corner and with the excellent rainfall we have had thus far, I am convinced that our residents with green thumbs cannot wait to start digging. Honorary Citizenship – Jaap Durand

I recently had the honour to award honorary citizenship to Professor Jaap Durand. Professor Durand is a legend in academic and theology circles. He is an alumnus of the University of Stellenbosch and gained recognition during his time at the University of Western Cape as Vice Rector. Professor Durand is a well-known anti-apartheid activist that focussed on creating a more inclusive environment for students and academics at UWC. He is also co-author of the Belhar Confession that is used by churches across the world.

Professor Durand was nominated for honorary citizenship by members of the civil society organisation, #MyStellenbosch. Upon completion of all the prerequisites as stipulated in our municipal bylaw, it was my great privilege to bestow this honour on him. We wanted to have a more formal ceremony for the Durand family but due to COVID-19 and the accompanying regulations, and in consultation with the Durand family, we conducted an
