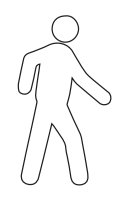

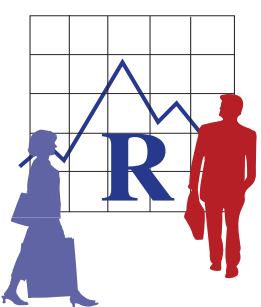

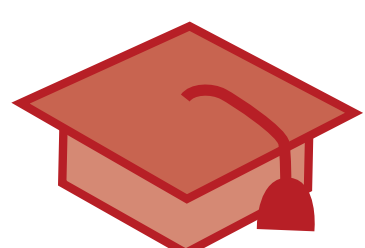

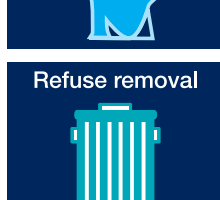

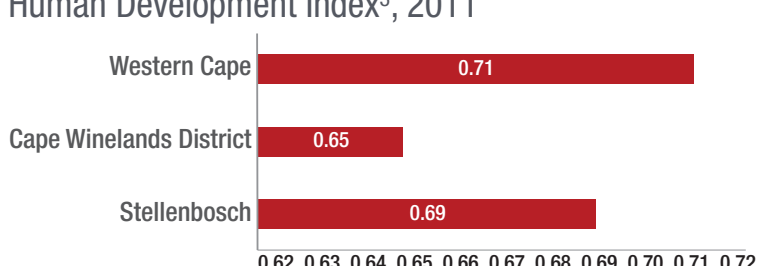

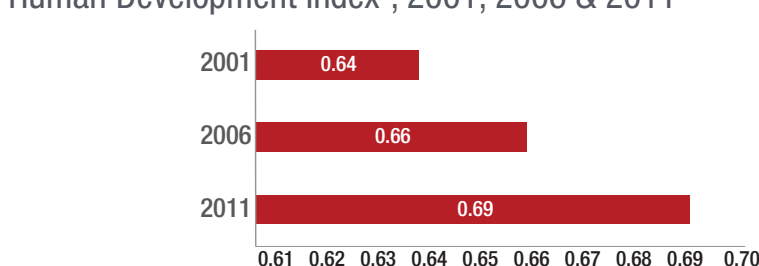

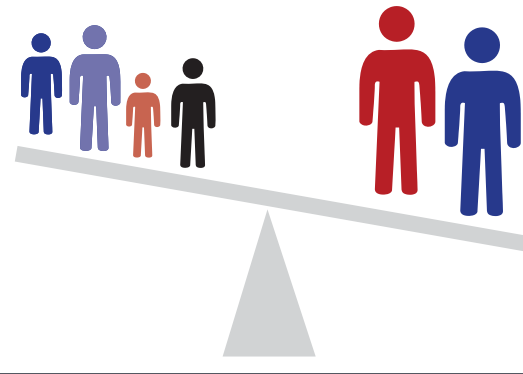

Stellenbosch Gini coefficient, 2001, 2006 & 2011⁶

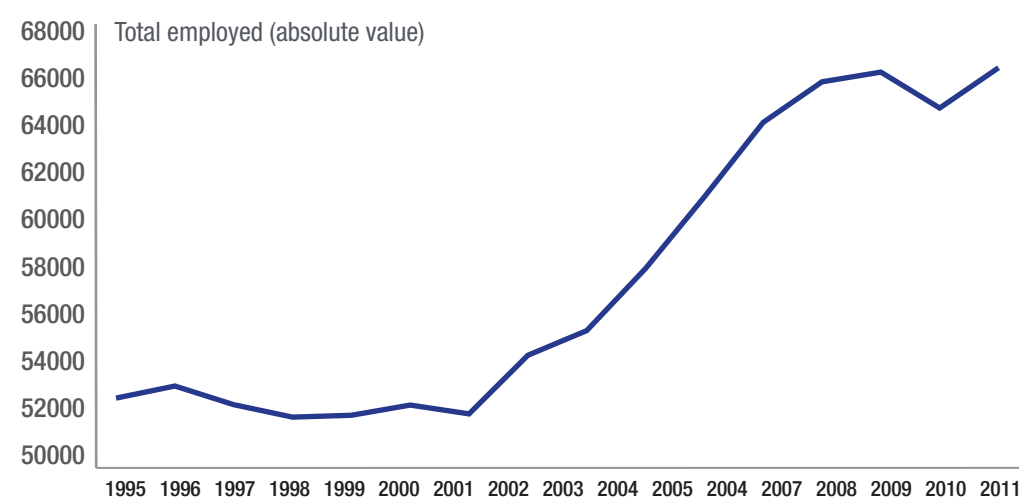

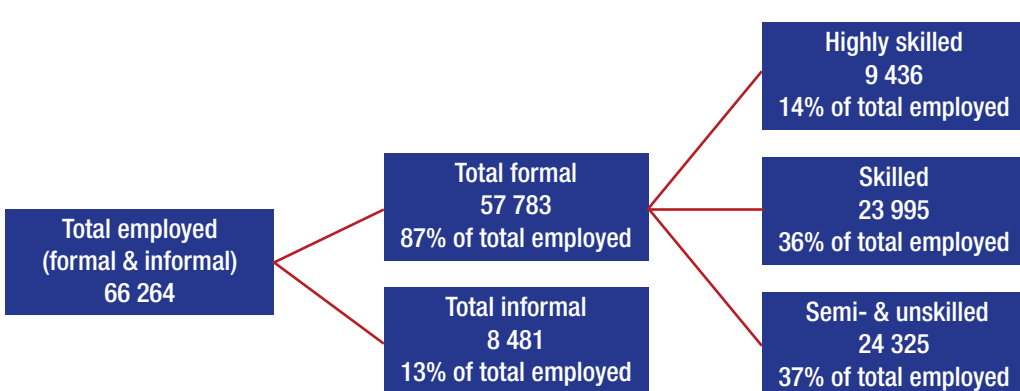

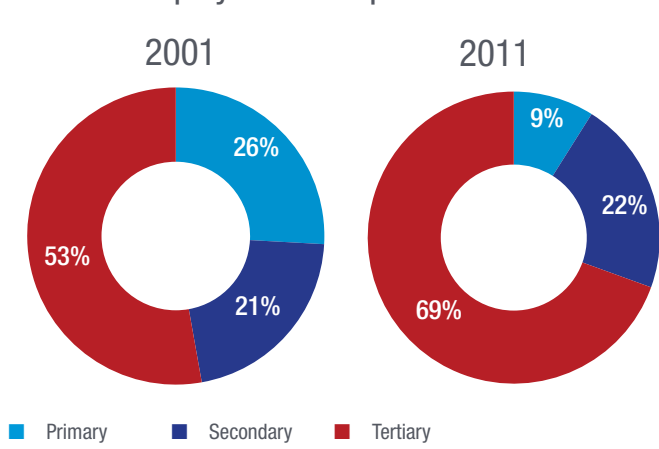


Formal/informal (2011)

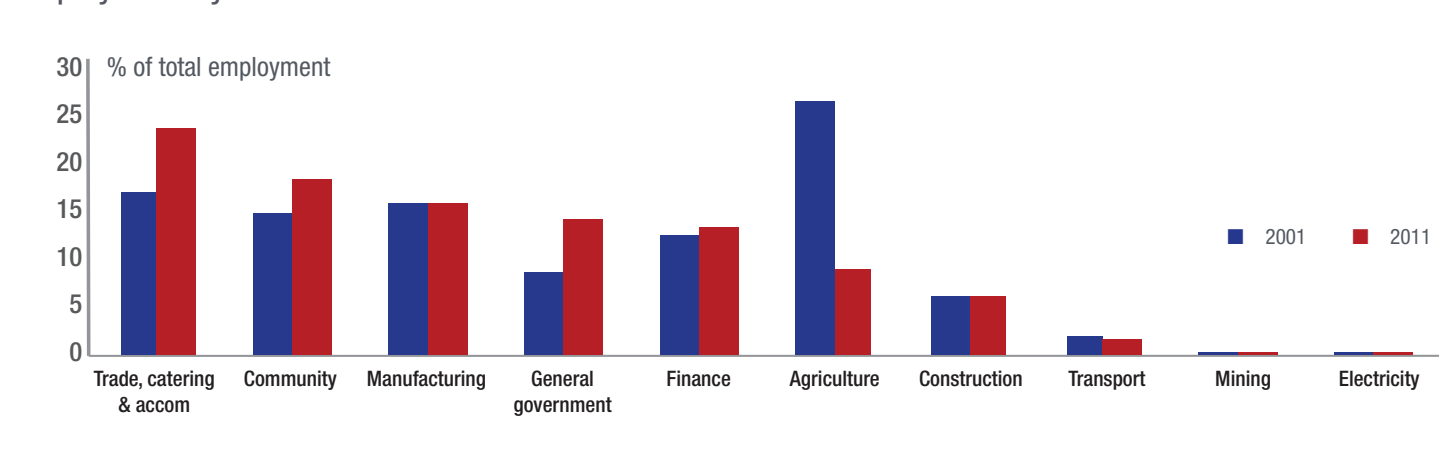

Sectoral employment composition

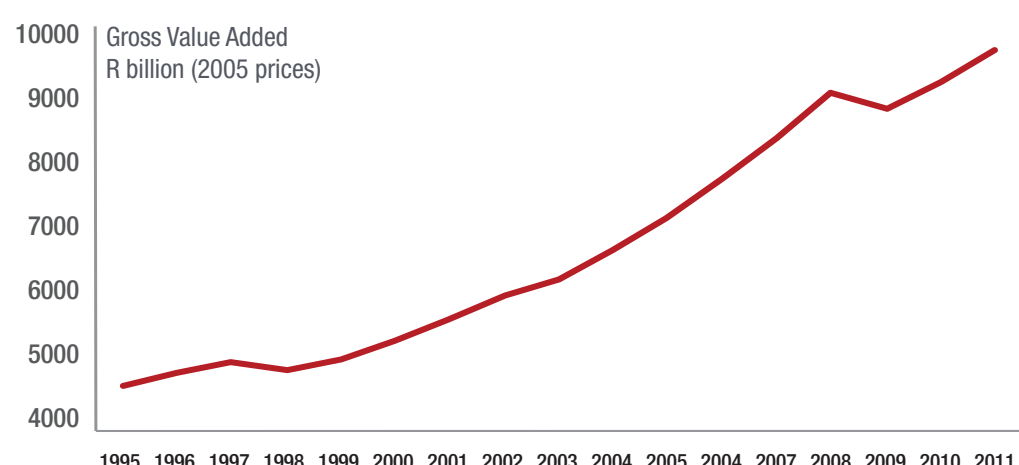


Employment by sub-sector

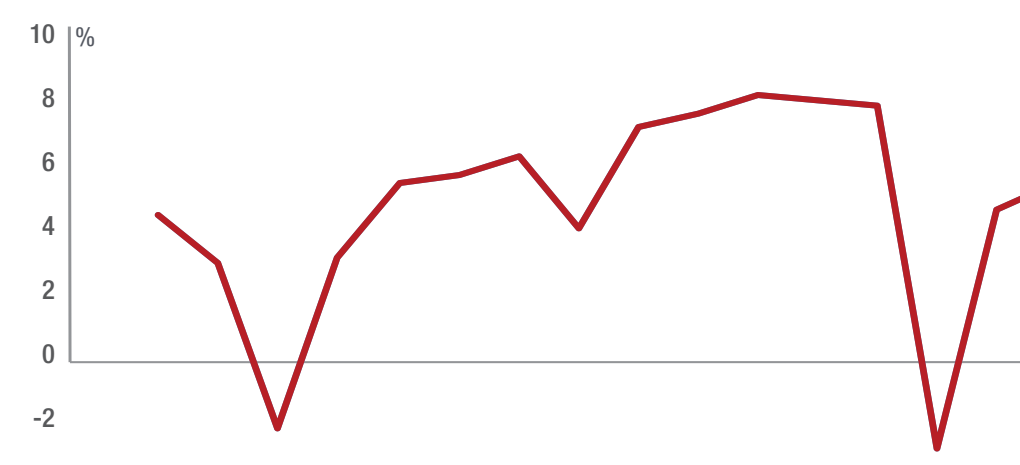

Gross value added⁸ (1995 – 2011)

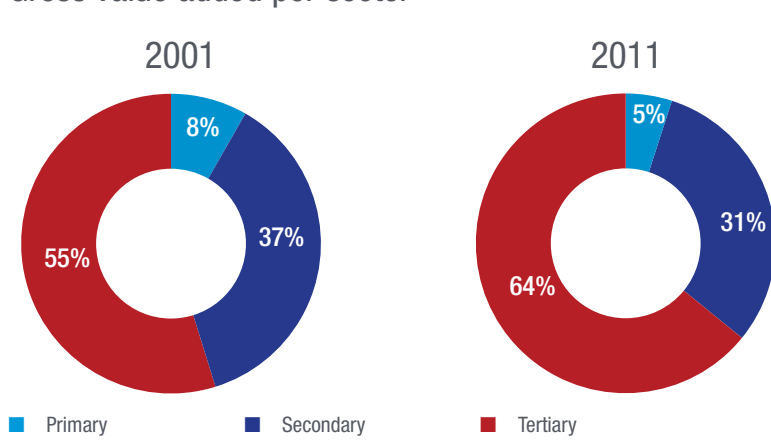


GVA growth (1995 – 2011)

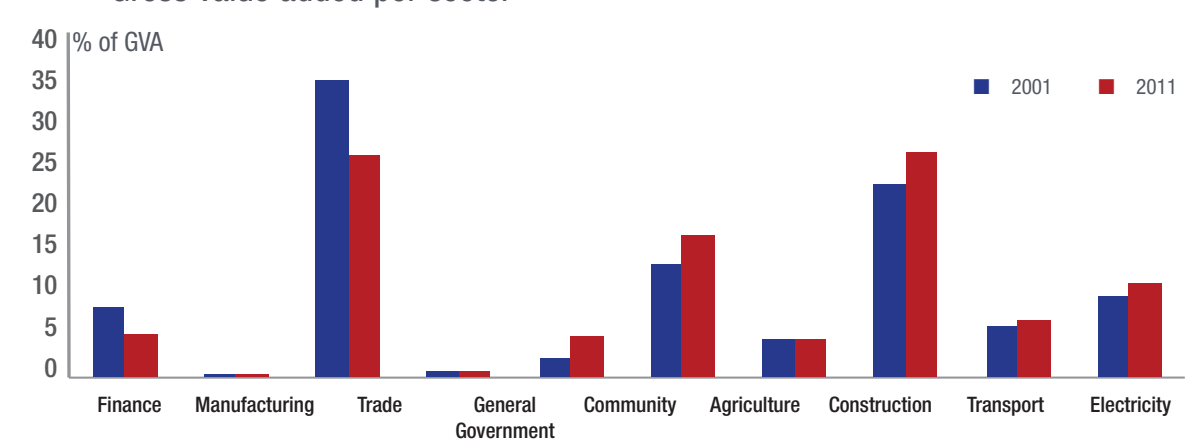

Gross value added per sector

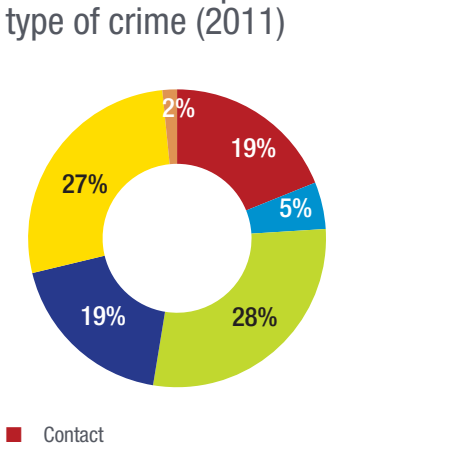

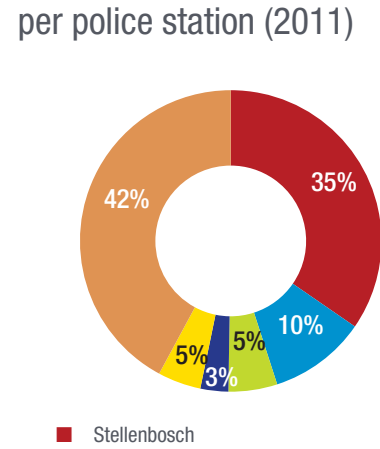
Total number of serious crimes reported (2001 – 2011)
