Gee Verantwoordelik is 'n veldtog wat poog om die verhandeling van kontant van ons strate te verminder en te beperk deur koepons te verkoop wat eerder aan hawelose mense gegee kan word. Die koepons kan dan ingegee word vir 'n bed in die nagskuiling of 'n bord kos, waar hawelose mense ook toegang kry tot sosiale en maatskaplike dienste. Hierdie veldtog werk! Sedert ons die veldtog met Heartflow geloods het in 2019, is ongeveer 16 000 koepons verkoop. Ons vennote sluit in Heartflow, Stellenthombu, Straatlig, Stellenbosch Nagskuiling, Stellenbosch Voedingsaksie en Visit Stellenbosch. As vennote werk ons, asook die Universiteit saam met die organisasies om mense wat in werklike nood verkeer te help. Die koepon-stelsel beperk die vloei van kontant op straat, en keer dat dit vir kansvatters winsgewend is om op straat te bedel. Dit stel ons in staat om te fokus op mense wat werklik hulp nodig het.
