WOORDFEES

LONGLANDS

After years of delays and several appointed contractors going bankrupt, a tripartite agreement between the Department of Human Settlements, Stellenbosch Municipality and Longlands Village Pty (Ltd) was entered into to fast-track the project.

The project includes the construction of roads, the installation of municipal services to 145 erven and the construction of 106 Breaking New Ground (BNG) houses. Work on the serviced sites began in May 2020 and construction of the new houses commenced in April 2022.

We also handed over certificates of appreciation to the nearly 50 workers who worked on this project - many of them from the community.

ILLEGAL DUMPING AND LITTERING

Our battle against illegal dumping and littering continues unabated. The directory showcases profiles of socio-economic development organisations working in the area, detailing their focus areas, contact details as well as ways in which the general public can get involved. Another great feature of the directory is that it is searchable by municipal ward and impact field (i.e., food security, youth development, education etc).

Organisations in the sector not yet registered on the website are encouraged to do so. The SCAN Website was sponsored by the Stellenbosch Municipality through Grant-in-Aid funding. We are proud to be working with SCAN as a platform to engage with all NGO's working in our local communities. The platform does not just provide access to information, possible partnerships and collaboration opportunities, but provides opportunity for the municipality to engage with this sector.

The municipality urges all local civil society organisations to join SCAN. Approving the Grant-in-Aid funding to build the website was a privilege and we look forward to many more fruitful engagements with SCAN.
