This situation is not enjoyable to anybody and it is almost unthinkable that after a year we would still be struggling with this, but if we are not alert and aware the whole time and do everything within our power to bring the situation under control, we may have to continue like this for a long time. Welcome back to all our students and learners. I think this year will be as unique and different as 2020 was. I want to ask our learners and students to help us stop the spread of COVID-19. I know our younger residents enjoy being social but I ask that parents, guardians and other authority figures please help us to keep our young people safe. Although younger people do not necessarily become very ill from the virus, and in many cases show no symptoms at all, they can still infect older people with the virus. Eikesaal

Ons bly heeltyd aan die woeker en werk om ons gemeenskapsfasiliteite op te knap en te onderhou. Aan die einde van verlede jaar, is die werk aan die Eikesaal in Cloetesville uiteindelik voltooi. Die Eikesaal is 'n baken vir die Cloetesville gemeenskap en die spasie word werklik goed gebruik deur die inwoners.

Dit was daarom nodig om 'n behoorlike opgradering aan die saal te doen. Die opgraderings het ingesluit die vervanging van die ou asbesdak, herstelwerk aan die vloer, verf van die gebou binne en buite, nuwe teëls in die badkamers, installering van 'n badkamer vir persone met gestremdhede, nuwe gordyne vir die verhoog, nuwe lugverkoeling, opgradering van die elektriese bedragting, nuwe LED ligte, 'n kragopwekker en nuwe sekuriteitstelsel. Die hele gebou voldoen ook nou aan al die voorgeskrewe brandregulasies. Die hele opgradering was is gedoen teen 'n bedrag van R4,8 miljoen.

Saam met die pragtige nuwe saal, wil ek 'n ernstige beroep doen op ons inwoners om ons asseblief te help om die saal op te pas en seker te maak dit bly so netjies en nuut. Vandalisme bly ongelukkig 'n groot probleem en ek kan nie genoeg klem daarop sit nie; Daar is nie geld om dit oor te doen nie! Elke liewe inwoner het 'n verantwoordelikheid om ons te help om ons bates, geboue en infrastruktuur op te pas. Moenie net toekyk hoe kriminele ons goed verniel nie. Bel die polisie, bel ons wetstoepassers en rapporteer dit onmiddellik. As elke inwoner ons help om ons dorpe op te pas en netjies te hou, sal ons maklik die mooiste streek in die wêreld wees en sal ons meer fondse tot ons beskikking hê om nog sale, parke en ander openbare spasies op te gradeer en netjies te maak.

Spaar Water

Ons damme is so mooi vol en as u gedurende die vakansie rondgery het, sou u ook al die vol damme kon sien en waardeer. Die provinsiale regering het egter 'n waarskuwing uitgereik om te sê dat watergebruik regoor die provinsie baie gestyg het. Ek wil tog 'n vra dat u nie sal ophou om water spaar nie. Alle waterbeperkings is sedert November 2020 opgeskort en dit is ook nou somer, maar onbeheerde watergebruik sal veroorsaak dat beperkings moontlik weer oorweeg moet word. As gevolg van aardverwarming bly weerpatrone onvoorspelbaar en moet ons seker maak ons spaar genoeg water, indien dit nie die komende winter genoeg reën nie. Ek is oortuig daarvan dat niemand weer wil terugkeer na vlak 4 of 5 waterbeperkings nie. Wees asseblief spaarsamig en pas weer al die goeie wenke toe, soos in die verlede.

Eike Hall

We have continuously remained active and busy to improve and renovate community facilities. At the end of last year the work on the Eike Hall in Cloetesville was finally completed. The Eike Hall is beacon for the Cloetesville community and a space that is put to good use by the residents.

It therefore became necessary to undertake a complete upgrade of the hall's facilities. The upgrades included the replacement of the asbestos roof, repair work to the floor, painting the building on the inside and outside, new tiles for the bathrooms, the installation of a new bathroom for people with disabilities, new curtains for the stage, new air conditioning, upgrading of the electrical wiring, new LED lights, a generator and a new security system. The entire building now also adheres to the prescribed fire prevention regulations. The cost of the project was R4, 8 million.

I want to seriously urge residents to please help us to take care of this facility so that it continues to look new and beautiful. Vandalism is unfortunately a big problem and I cannot emphasize it enough: We do not have the funds to redo this project! Every resident has a responsibility to help us protect our assets, buildings and infrastructure. Please do not just stand back and watch how criminals destroy your property. Call the police, call our law enforcement officers and report vandalism immediately. If every resident does his/ her part in looking after our towns, we will easily be the most beautiful region in the world and we will have more funds available to upgrade and beautify more parks, halls and public spaces.

Save Water

Our dams are filled up and if you were driving around the province during the holidays you may have seen these full dams and appreciate it as much as we do. The Provincial government has however issued a caution to warn that water usage in the province has increased dramatically. I want to ask you to please continue your efforts to save waters. All water restrictions were lifted in November 2020 and it is summer, but uncontrolled water usage might result in the reinstatement of some restrictions. Because of global warming, our weather patterns remain unpredictable and we must save enough water just in case the coming winter does not provide us with sufficient rain. I am convinced that no one wants to see a return to level 4 or 5 water restrictions. Please use water carefully and apply all the tips and tricks like we did in the past.
