Elektrisiteit

In my vorige nuusbrieff het ek u vertel van ons planne om te kyk of dit moontlik sal wees vir Stellenbosch Munisipaliteit om meer elektrisiteitsonafhanklik te wees, en so hopelik van beurtkrag ontslae te raak. Ons kry steeds baie navrae hieroor en ek wil u gerus uitnooi om enige vrae aan ons Direkteur van Infrastruktuur te stuur. Mnr Deon Louw is 'n gerekende en ervare ingenieur en sal help waar hy kan. U kan hom kontak via e-pos by Deon.Louw@stellenbosch.gov.za.

Baie van die vrae wat ons ontvang is ook vrae waarop ons self groter duidelikheid soek. Dit is dan juis waarom ons 'n wetenskaplike ondersoek doen na die proses, sodat ons nie tyd en hulpbronne mors nie. Dit is ongelooflik opwindend vir ons, maar nie iets wat ligtelik opgeneem of oorhaastig aangepak moet word nie.

Ons het gevolglik 'n memorandum van verstandhouding geteken saam met ons vennote by die Universiteit van Stellenbosch asook die Sentrum vir Wetenskaplike en Industriële Navorsing (CSIR).

Die memorandum stipuleer die rolle en verantwoordelikhede van elke party en die omvang van die ondersoek wat gedoen gaan word. Die ondersoek sal staatmaak op die intellektuele kapitaal van die Universiteit en die CSIR asook die infrastruktuur van die munisipaliteit om die energiebehoefte van ons gemeenskappe te bepaal met die verstandhouding dat alle partye op 'n nie partydige wyse saamwerk met besighede, industrieë, nie-regeringsorganisasies en die gemeenskapsorganisasies om moontlike oplossings vir volhoubare energie te ontwikkel.

'n Aparte memorandum sal later met die Wes-Kaapse regering gesluit word om hulle onafhanklikheid te behou wanneer dit kom by verkryging van dienste en ooreenkomste. Ons Premier, Alan Winde is saam met ons opgewonde en ondersteun ons ten volle.

U kan staatmaak daarop dat ons u deurlopend op hoogte hou sodat u nooit voel dat die proses nie deursigtig is nie. Baie dankie vir u geweldige belangstelling en positiewe terugvoer op die aankondiging. Dit is lekker om te weet ons inwoners staan agter ons!

Electricity

In my previous newsletter I told you about our plans to see if it would at all be possible for Stellenbosch Municipality to become more energy independent and, in doing so, put a stop to loadshedding. We still get many questions about this and I want to invite you to please send any queries to our Director of Infrastructure Services, Mr. Deon Louw. He is an experienced and knowledgeable engineer and will help where he can. You can send an email to Deon.Louw@stellenbosch.gov.za.

Many of the questions we receive are also questions we ourselves are seeking more clarity on. That is exactly why we are conducting a scientific investigation into this process, so that we don't waste time and resources on proposals that are not viable and sustainable. This is incredible exciting for us, but definitely not something we take lightly or want to rush into.

Consequently, we have signed a memorandum of understanding with our partners at the University of Stellenbosch as well as the Centre for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR).

The document sets out the roles of each party and the scope of the investigation. The investigation will draw on the extensive intellectual capital of the Stellenbosch University and the CSIR as well as the civic infrastructure of the municipality to address the energy developmental needs of our communities. In terms of the MOU, all parties will work in a non-partisan manner with local business and industry, non-governmental and community organisations towards sustainable energy development.

A separate MOU will be concluded with the Western Cape Government in order to facilitate their independence when dealing with procurement matters. The Premier, Alan Winde, shares our excitement and is in full support of this initiative.

You can trust that we will be keeping you informed throughout this process to ensure transparency. Thank you so much for the incredible interest and positive feedback on this announcement. It is nice to know our residents support us!

Budget and IDP

It is budget time again! At the end of March, I presented the draft budget for the next financial year (1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022) to Council. We have to tighten our belts a lot this year and every cent will be considered and debated so that we can make sure it is spent in the best interest of our residents. All our grants and funding from National and Provincial sources have been cut with 30% and this has a

Jonkershoekbrand

Aan die einde van Februarie was daar 'n reuse brand in die berge rondom Jonkershoek en Banhoek. Die brand het ontstaan in die Theewaterskloof Munisipaliteit en het later oorgekom na ons kant van die berg. Meer as 13 000 hektaar fynbos het in die slag gebly en dit het vir meer as 'n week gewoed. As gevolg van die wonderlike hulp van Provinsie en die Distriksmunisipaliteit is geen eiendom of menselewens verloor nie. Die naweek wat die brand krisispunt bereik het, het ons 'n beroep op ons inwoners gedoen om bystand te lewer aan al die brandbetryders deur die skenking van noodvoorraad soos water, energiedrankies, energiestafies ensovoorts. Binne 'n kwessie van 'n paar uur was ons stoorplek by die brandweerstasie van hoek tot kant vol! Ons was totaal oorweldig deur die vinnige en vrygewige optrede. Ek wil net weereens baie dankie sê aan al die inwoners wat so vinnig ingespring het om te help. U sal nooit weet hoe fantasties dit is om soveel meeewing te kan ervaar nie.

OVK

Vanjaar vind die vyfjaarlikse plaaslike regeringsverkiesings weer plaas. Dit beteken dat daar gestem gaan word vir nuwe raadslede vir alle munisipaliteite in Suid-Afrika. Ten tye van die skrywe, was die verkiesingsdatum nog nie bekend nie, maar ons weet dit sal binne 90 dae van die vorige plaaslike regeringsverkiesing se datum wees. Die wet bepaal dat die President die datum afkondig. Ons verwag die verkiesing so by Oktober 2021 se kant. Wat u as inwoner asseblief moet doen, is om solank u registrasiestatus te verseker. Omdat dit 'n plaaslike regeringsverkiesing is, kan u SLEGS stem in die wyk waar u woon. Daarom moet elke inwoner seker maak dat hulle in die regte wyk geregistreer is. Indien u onlangs getrek het van 'n ander dorp of selfs net binne dieselfde dorp, moet u herregistreer by die Onafhanklike Verkiesingskommissie (OVK).

Jonkershoek Fire

At the end of February we experienced a massive fire in the mountains surrounding Jonkershoek and Banhoek. The fire started in the Theewaterskloof Municipality and later moved into our area of the mountains. More than 13 000 hectares of fynbos were destroyed and the fire raged for more than a week. Because of the wonderful work of our fire fighters, together with crews from the District Municipality as well as the Provincial Government, no properties or human lives were lost. When the fire reached a crisis point, we called on our residents to provide assistance to the fire fighters by donating emergency supplies like water, energy drinks, power bars etc. Within mere hours, our storage facility at the fire station was filled to capacity! We were totally overwhelmed by your fast and generous actions. I want to say thank you to all our residents who stepped up and rendered aid so quickly. You cannot imagine what it means to see an outpouring of so much empathy and care.

Our heartfelt and sincere gratitude also goes out to the fire fighters who worked so very hard to bring the fires under control. The work you do requires an immense amount of courage and dedication. It is a comfort to know that we can rely on you.

IEC

The Local Government Elections will take place later this year. These elections happen every 5 years and it means that all the municipalities in the country will vote for new councillors. At the time of writing this, the election date has not yet been announced, but we expect it to be within 90 days from the date of the previous local government election. Legislation determines that the President must announce the date. We expect that the date will be somewhere in October 2021. In the meantime, as resident, you can ensure your registration status. Because it is a Local Government Election, you will ONLY be allowed to vote in the ward where you live. That is why every resident must ensure that they are correctly registered in the Ward they live in. If you moved recently
