The potable water in your area is supplied by the City of Cape Town and distributed by Stellenbosch Municipality. City of Cape Town informed Stellenbosch Municipality that urgent maintenance on the Blackheath Water Treatment Plant will be conducted from:

**MONDAY, 29 SEPTEMBER 2025 from 06:00
until FRIDAY, 03 OCTOBER 2025 at 23:59.**

Stellenbosch Municipality will ensure that reservoir levels are sufficient before the interruption commences to ensure that residents have uninterrupted water supply during the maintenance period. Residents in the **Polkadraai, Vloottenburg and surrounding areas** are however requested to use water sparingly during the maintenance period.

BLACKHEATH WATER TREATMENT PLANT SHUTDOWN NOTICE

The City of Cape Town, Water and Sanitation Directorate, will shut down the Blackheath Water Treatment Plant to accommodate necessary maintenance at the plant. The planned 5-day shutdown is scheduled for Monday, 29 September 2025, from 06:00 to Friday, 03 October at 23:59.

This shutdown will significantly reduce the overall production capacity of the Bulk water system. Therefore, we kindly request that all consumers city-wide use water sparingly during this period.

CoCT Retic: The reservoirs on the link pipeline will be supplied from Glen Garry. This may result in low pressures for Zevenwacht Reservoirs, Hasendal, and Protea Heights, including the Kraaifontein area, due to limitations on the shared Wemmershoek supply. The Glengarry-Tygerberg outflow will also be reduced. Please fill up the Blomtuin Reservoirs.

Drakenstein Municipality and Stellenbosch Municipality are also urged to fill up their reservoirs before the shutdown and to minimise draw-off from the Voelvlei, Wemmershoek and Blackheath pipelines during this time.

Please make the necessary arrangements to prepare for the shutdown. Please ensure that your reservoirs are filled to maintain a stable supply for your consumers.
