



To guide the planning, drafting, adoption and review of the

First Amendment of the 4<sup>th</sup> Generation Integrated Development Plan (2017/18 -2021/22)



### June 2019

#### Context

In terms of section 34(b) of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 (MSA):

"A municipal council may amend its integrated development plan (IDP) in accordance with a prescribed process."

The process for amending a municipal integrated development plan is outlined in regulation 3 of the Local Government: Municipal Planning and Performance Management Regulations of 2001 (MP&PMR).

By virtue of the fact that the municipality is in a state of readiness to adopt the new municipal Spatial Development Framework (*m*SDF) in accordance with section 20 (2) and 21 of the Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act 16 of 2013 (SPLUMA), an IDP Amendment process has been necessitated. Section 20(3) of SPLUMA requires that "before adopting the municipal SDF:

(1) and any proposed amendments to the municipal spatial development framework, the Municipal Council must—

- (a) give notice of the proposed municipal spatial development framework in the Gazette and the media;
- (b) invite the public to submit written representations in respect of the proposed municipal spatial development framework to the Municipal Council within 60 days after the publication of the notice referred to in paragraph (a); and
- (c) consider all representations received in respect of the proposed municipal spatial development framework.

The Draft *m*SDF has undergone a first phase of public consultation of 60 days which commenced on 8 March 2019 and ended on 8 May 2019. An additional 21 days public consultation will be undertaken alongside the IDP Amendment Process.

The process started in 2018 with the development of the Draft *m*SDF, which has been carefully consulted with the WC Department of Environmental Affairs and Planning. The Draft *m*SDF was tabled in Council and consulted for 60 days. Revision were made to the Draft *m*SDF after considering the various comments received. Having taken the feedback into account, it was agreed that the Draft *m*SDF should be revised and taken on an additional round of public comment, which is outlined in the processes following from June 2019. The processes prior to June, includes some of the key process undertaken to date as part of the development of the Draft *m*SDF.

The Draft *m*SDF and the IDP Amendment will run concurrently.
