THE STELLENBOSCH MUNICIPAL MAYORAL YOUTH SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME IS OFFERING

ACCREDITED BUILDING MAINTENANCE SKILLS TRAINING THROUGH STELLEMPLOY

Stellenbosch Municipality will train 13 unemployed young people (age 18 – 26) through *Stellemploy* in basic building maintenance skills. The training includes bricklaying-, carpentry-, plumbing- and painting skills. The training will be done over a period of 40 working days (17 October – 9 December 2022).

This course is accredited with the Construction-SETA.

What does the training include?

It includes all training, training material, refreshments, and transport from *Stellemploy's* office to the *Stellemploy* Training Centre and back. Service-SETA accredited Life Skills is part of the training programme (stipends will not be paid).

What are the application criteria?

- Valid South African ID
- Proof of residency in Stellenbosch Municipal Area (WC024)
 - Unemployed
- Minimum qualification: Grade 9 (able to do calculations, read and speak English)
 - Between the ages of 18-26 years
