

URGENT FAURE PIPELINE SHUTDOWN

Dear De Zalze, Jamestown residents and Farm owners on Annandale Road

The City of Cape Town, Water and Sanitation Department will shut the reservoir outlet at the Faure Water Treatment Plant to accommodate urgent maintenance on the 2400mm

diameter bulk pipeline near the Cape Town Film Studios. The planned 54-hour shutdown is scheduled for:

**Thursday, 16 March 2023, at 10:00, until
Saturday, 18 March 2023, at 16:00.**

The Stellenbosch Municipality will still receive supply from the Faure domestic tank but is requested to reduce consumption as the Plant will run at a low production rate.

Stellenbosch Municipality will ensure that reservoir levels are sufficient before the interruption commences to ensure that residents have uninterrupted water supply during the maintenance period. **De Zalze, Jamestown residents and Farmers on Annandale Road** are however requested to use water sparingly during the maintenance period.
